- FY09 to FY2010 General Government <u>Requested budget</u> increase: +5.15%
- Finance Committee recommended general government budget increase is 0.44%
- FY09 to FY2010 School Committee Requested operating budget increase: +4.5%
- Finance Committee recommended School budget decrease is -1.2%

Below are listed some of the larger percentage increases within this budget.

- Assessors: +4% (+\$10,266.00)
- Town Clerk: +3.8% (+\$5,815.00)
- Fire: +5.6% (+\$140,611.00)
- Conservation: +8.7% (+\$8,005.63)
- Animal Control: +31.7% (+\$ 24,315.00)
- Veterans: +17.7% (+\$53,350.00 (Mostly medical Cash Aid line item)

Since 2005, the average annual Town of Middleboro BUDGET increases are as follows:

- General Government: + 3.2% / year (Enterprise funds not included)
- School: +2.1% / year
- Employee Fringe Benefits: +12.5% / year.

Personnel Line items:

- FY09 to FY2010 General Government requested PERSONNEL budget increase: +4.31%
- Finance Committee recommended general government PERSONNEL budget increase is 0.11%.

Below are listed the departments with a 3 or more percentage point increase within the personnel lines. These budgets are based on the Town Managers request for level services.

Since 2005, the average annual Town of Middleboro PERSONNEL increases are as follows:

- General Government: + 3.23% / year (Enterprise funds not included)
- School: +3.43% / year. (Based on FY2010 level services / School Committee vote)
